Driver Rules & Schedule

Full-Day Registration/Driver's Meeting Registration and a short drivers meeting will be hosted in the Road Atlanta tower on Thursday, February 9th. Full Day Registration will be open from 7:00 AM – 7:30 AM in the tower with the **Mandatory Driver Meeting at 7:30 AM**. If you cannot attend the 7:30 AM driver meeting, a second meeting will be held at 9:00 AM. All participating drivers must sign in and sign the provided waivers at check in. Please See Minor Driver section below for drivers under 18 years of age.

Half-Day Registration/Driver's Meeting Half-day registration will open at 12:00 PM in the tower with a Mandatory Driver Meeting at 12:30 PM. All participating drivers must sign in and sign the provided waivers at check in. Please See Minor Driver section below for drivers under 18 years of age.

Full Day Schedule

- 7:30 AM Mandatory Drivers Meeting (First Floor of Tower)
- 8:00 AM 8:30 AM Sighting Laps (35 MPH Maximum. No Race Cars)
- 8:30 AM 12:00 PM Open Track (Registered Cars/Drivers Only. No Passengers)
- 12:00 PM 1:00 PM Lunch Full Day
- 1:00 PM 5:00 PM Open Track (Registered Cars/Drivers Only. No Passengers)

Note: WRL Load-In at 2 PM. Please ensure your rig/gear is in the correct space.

Half Day Schedule

- 12:00 PM Half-Day Registration/Check In (First Floor of Tower)
- 12:30 PM Mandatory Drivers Meeting (First Floor of Tower)
- 1:00 PM 5:00 PM Open Track (Registered Cars/Drivers Only. No Passengers)

Note: WRL Load-In at 2 PM. Please ensure your rig/gear is in the correct space.






Event Procedures

Paddock Rules The paddock speed limit will be 15 MPH. Drivers enter the pitlane from the middle gate and exit pits from the gate at the far end of pit lane right before track entry. There will be a Max Track Time employee checking wrist bands and windshield stickers before entering the track.

Pitlane Rules Pitlane speed limit will be 35 MPH. Fueling and work on the car (tire changes/mild repairs, etc.) are allowed in pit lane. All team members over the wall during fueling must be in full fire safety gear (fire suit, balaclava, fireproof shoes, and wearing a fire-safe full face helmet.) One member of the team over the wall must be ready with a fire extinguisher aimed at the car before fueling can commence.



Flag Rules This event will follow WRL flagging rules. A brief review of the flags has been listed below for your reference.

Single Yellow Flag – No passing from horizontal plane of the displayed yellow to the horizonal plane of the next station not displaying a yellow flag. While driving past the incident/safety workers, drive at a pace where you know you have 100% control over your own vehicle.

Black Flag – Return to pit lane.

Red Flag – Come to a controlled stop off-line by the nearest manned corner station.

Meatball Flag – If leaking fluids, pull off-line and come to a controlled stop near a manned corner station.





Event Requirements

Cars This event is for full race cars only. An exception can be made for time-trial cars with a minimum of a roll bar, racing seat, and racing harness. For questions about eligibility, please contact <u>info@maxtracktime.com</u>. Entrants are expected to prepare their car for the duties of track driving. Should a car be suspected of not being safe for track use, the organizers reserve the right to deny track access at any point during the event.

Drivers All drivers must have full racing gear including: Nomex Suit, SA2015/FIA2018 or newer Helmet, Racing Shoes, Balaclava, Nomex Socks, HANS device or comparable neck protection. Failure to have appropriate driving gear will result in denial of track access until appropriate gear is obtained.

MINOR DRIVERS Minors aged 16-17 are permitted to drive provided they have filled out our minor waiver. A legal parent or guardian must either be present, or have the waiver signed, notarized, and presented at the event for the minor to participate.

Facility/Track Damages Drivers/Teams are responsible for any damages to the Road Atlanta property including but not limited to fuel spills in the paddock, damaged Armco, tire barriers, etc. In the event facility damages are incurred, an invoice will be sent to the driver/team.
